



PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

This document is a guide for players attending and participating in UK Lions training sessions, matches, tours and tournaments. It outlines the expected minimum standards of behaviour.

Players will at all times, respect:

- the rules and regulations of hockey.
- the rules and regulations of any venue which they are attending.
- encourage the spirit of fair play.
- encourage the dignity and worth of others.
- umpires, officials, coaches, players of all teams and other spectators.
- understand and appreciate that the purpose of the activities is primarily the development and enjoyment of the sport, not just competing to win.

Players will:

- be punctual to meeting times, training and for matches.
- be dressed appropriately for the activity, wearing the UK Lions clothing where required.
- conduct themselves in a manner which protects their own safety and the safety of others.
- be familiar with and abide by England Hockey's anti-doping and equality policies.
- be aware, when participating in matches, that you are representing UK Lions and your respective Hockey Club and behave in a manner which preserves their reputations.

Players will never:

- smoke at any activity or meeting.
- participate whilst under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- use inappropriate or abusive language, bullying or threatening behaviour.
- act in anyway which bring the sport, UK Lions or your respective Hockey Club into disrepute.
